

REGULATIONS

Campground GP3R

GENERAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL:

Thursday August 12 from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m., Friday August 13 from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday August 14 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

DEPARTURE: You must vacate your campsite Sunday August 15 for 8 p.m. Please note there is no surveillance after Sunday 8 p.m.

REFUNDS: There is NO REFUND for early departure.

CANCELLATION: Cancellation can be made without penalty fees up to seven (7) days before GP3R events.

- 1. All campers and visitors must abide by these following rules. Anyone violating any campground regulation may be subject to penalties or expulsion. After warning, violators will be expelled without any refund.**

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

2. Campers must take good care of GP3R Campground equipment at all times. They must leave their sites and any equipment they use in clean and proper order. Users may be billed for any damage done to campground equipment or ground. Trash must be placed in plastic bags and disposed of in designed trash containers located at the entrance of the camp ground.
- 3. Campfires are not allowed on our campground.**
4. Campers are asked to respect the natural environment. Cutting or damaging trees is prohibited.
5. GP3R cannot be held responsible for any material damage or personal injury to campers or visitors because of pets admitted to the campground, partial or total power failure, falling trees, fire, vandalism, theft, or material loss.

COVID-19

1. 2 meters (6 feet) must be kept at all time between people from different family.
2. All people entering the site must be registered and sign the Covid declaration.
3. If you are self-isolated you can't acces the site and if you have any of the covid-19 symptoms, do not show on site.
4. If you develop symptoms during your stay, you have to leave the campground immediately.
5. Signage must be respected inside the building of the École des Pionniers.
6. Desinfection of hands must be done prior to enter the building.

7. Shower user must clean the shower before and after usage with furniture provided.
8. Mask is mandatory inside the building.

CIRCULATION

All motor traffic is prohibited on GP3R campground, except to access your location. The campground speed limit is 5 mph at any time. Motorcycles, mini-bikes, motocross and all-terrain vehicles are not allowed.

PARKING

One vehicle per campsite with a motorized, a caravan, a tent caravan or a tent will be authorized. Visitors and additional vehicles are allowed if you purchase a parking space in designated area for \$25 for all week-end long.

CURFEW

Campers must refrain from making excessive noise (music and parties) between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. The use of generators, noisy appliances, and lighting systems is not permitted during curfew hours.

PETS

Pets are welcome on GP3R Campground but they must be kept on a leash, in a cage, or in a suitable vehicle. Excrements must be disposed of in garbage bags.

COMMODITIES

Water supplies and electricity are not available. If needed, an outside water supply (faucet) is available.

Campers are allowed to use the showers and toilets located in the Des Pionniers school from 6 a.m. to midnight. Campers must leave the place clean and no other circulation in the school will be permitted. Chemical toilets are available at all times on site.

Smoking is strictly forbidden in the Des Pionniers School and alcoholic drinks consumption will not be tolerated inside the school either.

ACCESS TO GP3R SITE

Please note that access to the GP3R site has changed due to covid-19 restrictions. People with tickets for Site Cogeco need to access the site via entrance located on the corner of Des Forges Boulevard and Papineau street. People with tickets for Site Bell need to access the site via entrance located on the horsetrack of the Hippodrome 3R.
