

CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS GP3R CAMPSITE

GENERAL INFORMATION

Arrival :

For the weekend: Thursday, August 8th, 2024 from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m., Friday, August 9th, 2024 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Departure : You must vacate your campsite no later than Sunday evening August 11, 2024 at 8 p.m. It is possible to leave your RV or tent on site until Monday morning, but please note that you are totally responsible and that no security will be on site. Access to the Pionniers school will no longer be available from the Sunday after the last race Access to the Pavillon des Sciences at Cégep de Trois-Rivières will no longer be available from 6 p.m. on Sunday.

Refund: No refunds will be made for early departures.

Cancellation : Cancellation of your reservation will be possible if it is made within seven (7) days preceding the event.

Any tenant or visitor is required to comply with these regulations. Any person who violates any of these regulations is subject to sanctions and expulsion without reimbursement after warning.

ENVIRONMENT

At all times, campers must respect the GP3R campsite equipment. They must leave their campsite and any equipment they use in a clean and good condition. Any damage caused to campsite equipment may be charged to the customer. In addition, the tenant undertakes to put his garbage in plastic bags and deposit them in the dumpster installed for this purpose on the site. Recycling must be put in transparent bags and placed in the containers provided for this purpose. Transparent bags will be available at reception. Returnable cans will be collected by the Braves Rugby Club. Bins will also be available to properly dispose of wine bottles.

Campfires are strictly prohibited on sites, including propane fires at both campsites.

It is strictly forbidden to cut down, even lightly, or damage in any way the trees in the campsite.

The GP3R cannot be held responsible for any material damage or personal injury caused to campers or visitors by domestic animals allowed on the site, a partial or total lack of electricity or water, falling trees, fire or vandalism – nor held responsible for theft or loss of equipment.



CIRCULATION

All motor traffic is prohibited on the GP3R campground, except to get to your campsite. The campground speed limit is 5 KM/H at any time. Motorcycles, motocross, mini-bikes, and all-terrain vehicles are prohibited. Golf carts are prohibited on public roads under penalty of fines and vehicle seizure.

PARKING

One vehicle per campsite (motorized, trailer, tent-trailer or tent) will be authorized. A sticker permit will be given to you upon your arrival and must remain stuck in your windshield throughout the weekend. Visitors and excess vehicles are permitted at a cost of \$30 for the weekend in a designated parking area.

CURFEW:

Campers must refrain from making excessive noise between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. The use of generators, noisy appliances, or lighting systems is prohibited during the curfew period.

PETS:

Animals are accepted on the site. They must be kept on a leash, put in a cage or a suitable vehicle. Excrements must be collected by the person responsible for the pet and disposed of in garbage bags.

FACILITIES :

- Water supplies and electricity are not provided. If needed, an outside water supply (faucet) is available.
- Campers are allowed to use the showers and toilets located in the Des Pionniers school from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. For the Cegep campsite, showers and toilets are available at the Pavillon des Sciences (entrance on rue de Courval), on Thursday from 4 p.m. to 10 p.m., Friday and Saturday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. and Sunday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. No other access inside the school is permitted, and campers must ensure the washrooms are left clean. Chemical toilets are available on site at all times.
- Access to the school and its facilities will be impossible starting from the end of the last race on Sunday, August 11. Access to the Cégep and its amenities will be impossible from 6 p.m. on Sunday
- Smoking is strictly forbidden in the Des Pionniers School and in the Pavillon des Sciences of the Cegep. Alcoholic drinks consumption will not be tolerated inside the schools either.



• Generators built into the RV are permitted. The use of an external generator is also permitted, but it must be turned off from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
